
PRIORITY: YOU

In addition to enhanced cleaning protocols, a team of Sanitization Specialists will join Staples Studio to proivide daily, continuous cleaning.

ENTRY PROTOCOLS

Welcoming you with healthy and safe entry protocols.

Every member should feel comfortable and safe at Staples Studio, so we are introducing a new process for all guests and members entering the space.



Welcome Check-in

Members and guests should wait for the Studio Manager when entering to ensure awareness of our Community Wellness Standards.



Masks On Please

Members and guests are asked to wear a face covering while in Studio, following local ordinances and CDC recommendations,



Clean Hands

Please use hand sanitizer or wash your hands before and after touching shared appliances and equipment.



Virtual Tours

To help keep our locations healthy and safe, scheduled tours will be conducted virtually.



BEFORE YOU VISIT

Members and guests entering a Staples Studio location are asked to pass these three health checks.



Is your temperature over 100° F?



Have you been in contact with someone testing positive for COVID-19?



Do you have symptoms like fever, cough, chills, muscle aches, headache, sore throat or shortness of breath?

We ask that anyone answering yes to one of these questions remains at home to help maintain a healthy and safe coworking space for our community.





PHYSICAL DISTANCING



Adjusting layout and flow to support physical distancing.

We ask for your help by following one way flows, seating guidelines and room occupancy limits.



One Way Flow

Floor decals and wall signs throughout each location will indicate one way flow to support physical distancing.



Maximum Room Occupancy

Each room will have occupancy limits, including open seating, copy rooms and meeting rooms.



Seating Changes

Open seating capacity has been reduced and reconfigured at each location to provide more space between members.



Closed Workstations

Certain workstations will be marked as closed to support physical distancing.







SANITIZING STATIONS

Adding stations for sanitization and cleanliness.

We have collaborated with workspace sanitization experts to introduce critical cleaning and sanitizing products and fixtures throughout our locations.





Sanitizing Stations

Members will have access to sanitizing wipes, latex gloves, hand sanitizer and masks at the entrace of each Studio.



Reusable Masks

All members will be provided a reusable mask to comply with local ordinances.



Touchless Dispensers

Touchless hand sanitizing dispensers will be located at all high touchpoint areas as well as entrances and exits.





ENHANCED SANITIZATION

Enhancing our sanitization protocols and frequency.

We are dedicated to implementing new policies and practices to elevate the standards of cleanliness at Staples Studio.



Sanitization Team

A Sanitization Specialist will be hired for each location to help provide dedicated and continuous cleaning support.



New Cleaning Standards

We have developed new cleaning responsibilities, procedures and standards for our locations.




Snacks & Coffee

Disposable cups will be provided for continued coffee service, but snacks will be temporarily removed for member health.



Lunch Containers

Members will be provided a sanitized container to store outside food in the refrigerator.







TOUCHLESS ELEMENTS

Implementing touchless elements to reduce cross-contact.

Working with experts we have identified high-traffic and high-touch areas where we are implementing touchless elements or replacements to help slow spreading germs.





Touchless Access

New fixtures will help to reduce the number of surfaces members need to touch with their hands.



Touchless Dispensers

We are adding touchless dispeners for paper towels, hand sanitizer and disposable cutlery.



Expanding Touchless

We will continue to identify and add more touchless elements throughout Studio.
